On Thursday the 16th of November 2023 at 02:01 UTC, Flight NPI-F2, a Boeing 787, touched down at Troll Airfield in Antarctica after a remarkable journey from Oslo. The event marked a historic moment as it was the first-ever landing of a Boeing 787 in Antarctica, showcasing the prowess of modern aviation.

Our team worked tirelessly to ensure the smooth and efficient handling of cargo, people movements and preparations in Cape Town, demonstrating our commitment to precision and excellence in every aspect of logistics support, to assist with preparations of the aircraft before its flight to Antarctica.

Upon landing, NPI-F2 spent 4 hours and 22 minutes on the runway at Troll Airfield, engaging in meticulous cargo operations, provisions deliveries and people movements.

Following the successful operations at Troll Airfield, NPI-F2 departed for its return journey to Cape Town at 06:23 UTC. The aircraft landed back in Cape Town at 11:26 UTC / 13:26 LT on the same day.

After a brief stay in Cape Town, NPI-F2 departed for Oslo on Friday, 17th November 2023, at 16:46 / 18:46 LT.
