1. --- Fujairah – Phased Out Single Hull Tankers ---

The following information was provided by Kanoo Shipping, Fujairah.

Capt. Tamer Masoud, the Harbour Master of the Port of Fujairah issued a Notice to Mariners no. 139 / 2010 concerning phased out single hull tankers.

Notice to Mariner No. 139/2010

Subject: Phased Out Single Hull Tankers

Further to the last Notice to Mariner No. 113 dated 10th June 2008, please note that following:

- 1. Phased out single hull tankers as per MARPOL 73/78 are not allowed for any cargo operation in Fujairah (Oil terminals and F. O. A. A.).**
- 2. Phased out single hull tankers are allowed to call Fujairah Offshore Anchorage Area in ballast condition to receive primary requirements and should leave from Fujairah Anchorage immediately after completion of aforesaid services.**
- 3. Phased out single hull tankers are not allowed to wait for orders.**
- 4. Single hull tankers still not phased out are permitted for cargo operation and is subject to submission of documents as per Notice to Mariners No. 84.**

2. --- Egypt – Circular No. 4/2010 Concerning Vessels Carrying Dangerous Cargo ---

The following information was provided by Kanoo Shipping associated office, Egypt.

Eng. Mostafa Mahmoud Saleh, the Director of the Transit Department of the Suez Canal Authority issued a circular no. 4/2010 concerning vessels carrying dangerous cargo:

Excerpts given below:

- Quote -

Article One:

It has been recently noticed that many owners of vessels classified as "general cargo vessels" or "general cargo / container vessels" submit new classification certificate that the vessel is a "multi – purpose vessel", despite the fact that no alterations are made to the vessel.

It is, therefore, decided that the SCA shall apply Item (12) of Article (57) of the SV Rules of Navigation on "Multi – purpose vessels", as well as vessels classified as "general cargo", and "general cargo / container vessel".

Article Two:

This circular shall be effective as of 1/6/2010. the local port authorities of both Ras Al Khaimah and Sharjah have released their latest tariff rates for the year 2010.
